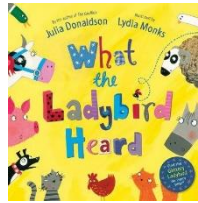

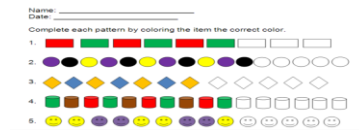
This term we will be reading and exploring the book 'What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson. This book tells the story of how a ladybird, with the help of the farm animals, work together to stop the robbers from stealing the prized cow.

Overall aims:

- To engage with fictional texts and listen to and enjoy stories
- To sequence and order events within the stories
- To engage with character feelings and emotions.
- Explore vocabulary and book talk
- Use captions, labels and mark making.

This term we will be focusing on looking at creating our own map, looking at rhyming words, writing captions, labels and speech bubbles. Please continue to help and support your child with learning to read and write.

Mathematics



This term we are focusing on **counting, patterns and symmetry**.

Within reception, we will be continuing to learn our numbers up to 10 and then 20. We will continue to use 10 frames: practising reading, writing, saying and knowing what each numeral represents in a variety of ways. We will be solving real life problems by both addition and subtraction We will also be looking at patterns and symmetry. Our key vocabulary: repeating, symmetrical, one more, one less and knowing numerals 1-10 and then 1-20 in order. Please continue to support your child with number formation and counting.

Phonics

This term we will be continuing to learn phase 2 phonic groups. These include: CK, E U R H B F FF L LL and SS.

Throughout the term, as well learning each of the separate sounds, we will also be learning how to segment and blend the sounds together to read CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words. We will also be learning how to build words using our sounds.

High frequency words we will be learning are:-

Mum, big, got, back, off, put, his, had, but, go.

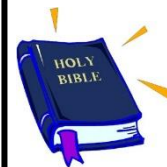
