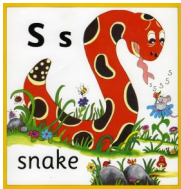
Literacy

Mathematics

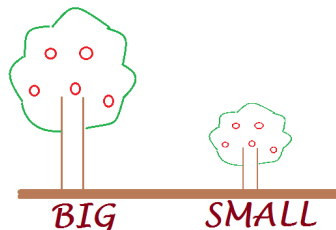
Children are continuing to learn about different numbers and are being encouraged to say what is one more than a number.

We will begin to learn and explore measuring and ordering by size.

We will be using a variety of instruments to measure the objects and compare their size.

Overall aims:

- To be able to order by size.
- To use correct language when exploring size.
- To count and order to five.



Topic

This term our topic is **Natural World**.

This term we will be learning all about the world around us.

We will be exploring nature and life cycles of mini-beasts whilst also learning about animals that no longer exist, dinosaurs..

Overall aims for Personal, Social and Emotional development:
