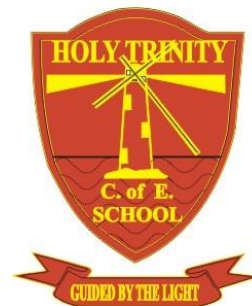

Enriched Curriculum/PE kits

Dear parent, carer, guardian,

I trust that you are well and have enjoyed hearing from your child about the start of their new school year – I have enjoyed meeting lots of new faces and thank you to those of you who I have spoken to already – I have been made to feel very welcome.

I am working with the staff team looking at our curriculum provision and I have been so impressed to hear of all the wonderful learning and activities that children experienced as part of their *Wonderful Wednesday* or *Terrific Thursday*. As mentioned in my head teacher welcome letter, we have adapted the subject timings and internal structures to ensure that pupils gain key knowledge, skills and experiences. This means that those activities previously taught on those enriched curriculum days will be integrated throughout the week, term and school year.

This means, children will no-longer need to wear their own clothes to school on a Wednesday or Thursday with immediate effect (from Wednesday 7th September). Children should arrive in their regular school uniform please. I sincerely apologise for the very late notice regarding the above.

In regards to PE, lessons will resume next week (commencing Monday 12th September), and you will be receive a letter informing you what day your child's PE day will be. **On this day they can come into school wearing their PE kit.** This saves time and enables children to participate right from the start of the lesson and time is not wasted changing.

Our uniform policy will be shared shortly but our PE kit consists of:

- White polo neck t-shirt (a hoodie/jacket can be worn in the winter months)
- Black shorts (joggers in the winter months)
- Trainers or plimsols

Please do not send your child into school in football kits and ensure that all jewellery is removed on those days.

We would also like to give you advance notice that as a school we will not be participating in the Roald Dahl day event next week in recognition of the current economic pressures. Therefore, there is no need for you to go to the expense of purchasing outfits of costumes.

We will shortly be sharing our annual calendar of events to the school community – there will be plenty of other opportunities in the year for children to dress up as part of non-uniform and/or charity events.
