<b>i</b> Hola!	The letter <b>h</b> is always silent in Spanish.

adi <b>ó</b> s, <b>no</b>	The letter <b>o</b> makes the sound like 'o' in stop.
<b>bi</b> en, <b>sí</b>	The letter <b>i</b> in Spanish, makes the sound 'ee', like a big, chEEsy grin.
