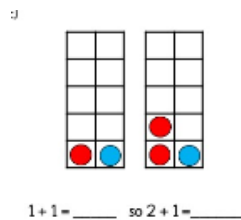

Mathematics

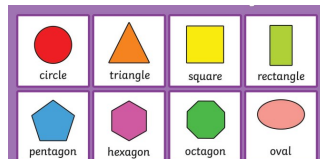
Maths hub

Wider Curriculum

This term, we will be exploring the subject of History in which our topic will be 'How am I making history?'. We will learn about our history and develop an understanding of personal chronology. We will also learn words and phrases related to the passage of time. We will explore artefacts to help us understand childhood in the past and how childhood has changed over time.



Science

Everyday Materials:

We will be learning about everyday materials and recognising that objects are made from various materials that suit their purpose. We will be exploring their different properties (For example: absorbent, waterproof and tough)



RE

In RE, Year 1 will be learning about **Incarnation**, we will be exploring:
