Spanish - Where do you live in Spain?

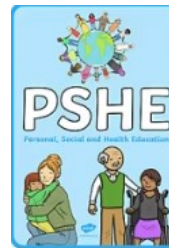
This term children will be:

We will be explaining how life is influenced positively either by people we know or by people from other countries.

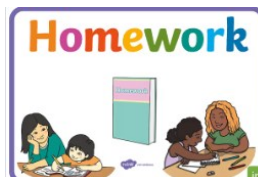

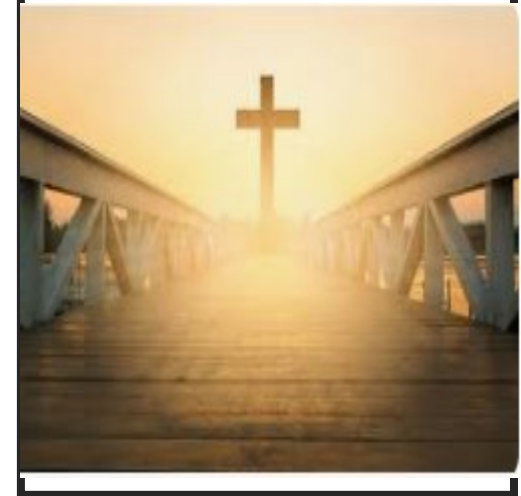

We will be exploring newspaper features and the story of Ernest Shackleton to understand and produce persuasive newspaper texts.

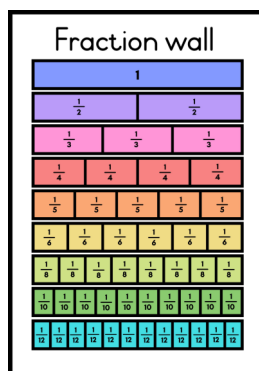

This term we will be looking at the kingdom of God and 'When Jesus left what was the impact of Pentecost'

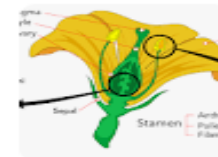
- What is Pentecost?
