- To play by the rules .

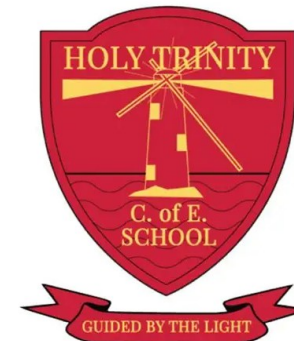
## Homework

## History

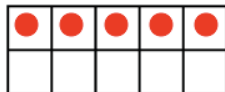
In History, this term we are going to be looking at Queen Victoria.

## Mathematics

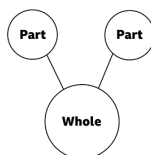
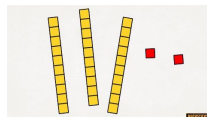
### Maths hub
