
Year 5 Term 1 Curriculum Booklet

English

In English, we will explore Greek myths, beginning with the story of Theseus and the Minotaur. Children will learn to retell, adapt, and eventually create their own myths, building rich vocabulary and developing their sentence writing skills. Later in the term, we will turn our attention to non-fiction writing, where pupils will research and create an information text about different biomes, such as rainforests, deserts, and tundra.

Mathematics

This term in Maths, Year 5 will focus on identifying place value and using that understanding to compare and round numbers. After that, we will move onto tackling addition and subtraction with larger numbers, as well as how to approach multi-step problems logically.

Weekly Freckle Tasks will continue to be set on a Friday.

Wider Curriculum: Science & Geography/ History

In Science, Year 5 will be learning about forces. We will be exploring the effect of gravity, air and water resistance, friction, and mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears.

In History, we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We'll identify when and how they lived, how their city-states differed, and how their democracy worked. In Geography, we will be studying the different biomes across the globe and the differences in life found there.

Music

This term we will explore melody and harmony, learning how tunes and chords work together in music. Our focus question is "How does music bring us together?" Children will enjoy singing, playing instruments, composing, and performing while developing creativity, confidence, and teamwork.

This term in PE, Year 5 will focus on Tennis, in which we will be developing their ability to serve and volley balls. We will also be exploring Communication & Tactics to refine the pupil's abilities to apply effective teamwork, problem-solving, and communication skills.


