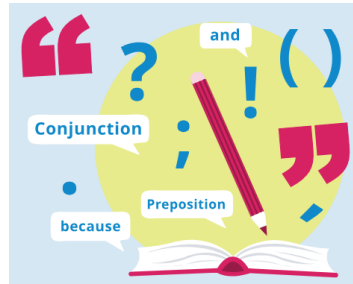


Grammar, punctuation and spelling:

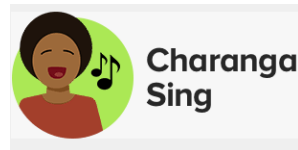
This term, we will be focussing on:

In PSHE we will be exploring our dreams and goals, steps to success and plans for the future.

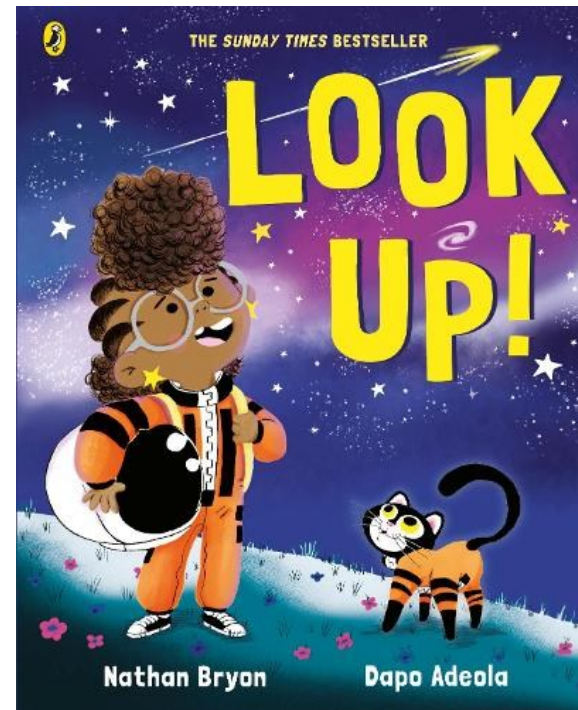


PE

Our PE day is **Thursday** will include the units **Linking (gymnastics) and Jumping 1** lesson for Year 2.

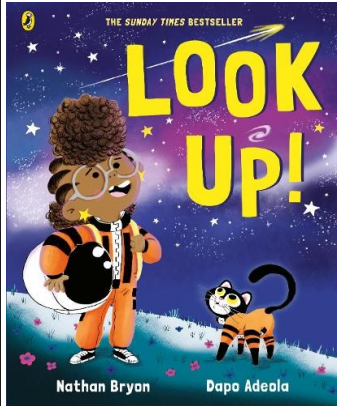

English



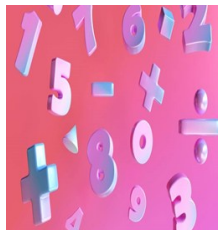
In English, we are looking at the book 'Look up!'. We will be:
