


We will be looking at explanation texts and fairy tales.

We will be using 'The Iron Man' to inspire our work this term.

This book links back to our work on forces and magnets, as well as the material 'iron' which was used to make tools and weapons in the Iron Age.

We will be identifying the parts of an explanation text, using model texts based on our book. We will then plan and create our own explanation texts for an invention.

We will then write descriptive and narrative fairy tales based on the same book.



Maths

We start this term with multiplication and division— multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by a single digit.

We will then move on to measurement and perimeter of shapes.



R.E.

Our 'big question' is 'What is important for Sikh people?'

We will be looking at:

- What Sikhs believe about God
- How Sikh history impacts their beliefs and actions
- What signs Sikhs use to show their faith

Pupils will develop their games skills in dodgeball. They will also develop a sequence of balances linked by transition movements in our gym topic of unison and canon, moving together and in sequence.


Spanish

Science - Plants


In Science we will be learning about:
