- Mass and Capacity




## Science

In Science we will be looking at Humans and Animals.

We will:

- Describe the basic needs of animals including humans.
- Discuss the life cycles of animal and humans.
- Describe the importance of exercise, diet and hygiene.

## Wider Curriculum- Geography

In Geography we will be exploring the U.K.

We will:

- Explore each country and it's capital city.
- Identify key landmarks in each country.
- Compare the U.K's four countries.



## RE

In RE, Year 2 will be learning about **Salvation**. We will learn:

- Recognise that Incarnation and Salvation are part of a 'big story' of the Bible.
- Tell stories of Holy Week and Easter from the Bible and recognise a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave.
- Give at least three examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death and resurrection in church worship at Easter.
- Think, talk and ask questions about whether the story of Easter has anything to say to them about sadness, hope or heaven, exploring different ideas.
