
English

We will be looking at instructions and journey tales.

We will continue using 'The Iron Man' to inspire our work this term.

We will be identifying the parts of an instruction text, using model texts based on our book. We will then plan and create our own instruction texts with a focus on: time adverbials, imperative verbs, headings, sub-headings and numbered steps.

We will then write journey tales with a focus on: expanded noun phrases, paragraphs, a wide range of conjunctions and the use of apostrophes for omission and possession.



Maths

We start this term completing our measurement work before moving on to fractions. We will be finding out about unit and non-unit fractions - identifying fractions of shapes, before comparing fractions.

We will develop our Spanish conversation skills this term.




P.S.H.E. - Healthy me


Weekly spellings are sent home each Monday for a quiz on the Friday.

Accelerated Reader daily home reading - completing 5 comprehension quizzes this term in school.




Science Week - light and shadows
